BEEF BREEDING & FEEDER CALF BEEF RULES

GENERAL RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

1. Any boy or girl enrolled in a Stark County youth organization is eligible. They must abide by the rules and age limitations of said youth organization (4-H, FFA, etc.)
2. Exhibitors must be enrolled in a Beef Breeding and/or Beef Feeder Calf project.
3. The Junior Fair exhibitor must have an animal which is either a purebred beef animal or a crossbred (having a beef sire) animal.
4. The Junior Fair animal must be in the member's care by June 1, 2010.

It is mandatory for all Junior Fair exhibitors of market and lactating animals to attend a QUALITY ASSURANCE CLINIC prior to the Fair and complete a DRUG USE NOTIFICATION FORM (DUNF) prior to the show. Those who do not comply will not be allowed to show! Ohio Revised Code 901-19-06 and 901-19-07 Mandated by the Ohio Department of Agriculture. All Junior Fair Market and lactating Livestock should be drug residue free on the first day of the Fair unless specified on the DUNF.

5. No one is to handle a junior fair member's animals without the permission of the junior fair exhibitor unless there is an emergency. Committee members may handle animals during the normal course of their duties (i.e., show, sale, weigh-in, pictures, loading, unloading).
6. All beef breeding/feeder calf animals will be housed and displayed in the designated area at the county fair.
7. Horns are permissible, but are discouraged.
8. Beef breeding animals will show in classes by breed and age. Whether a championship is awarded or not, is entirely at the discretion of the judge. No project animal NOT earning an "A" grade, will be considered for a champion award. First place class winners will compete for Grand Champion and Reserve Champion honors.
9. Advertising apparel is not permitted to be worn in the judging ring.
10. Members must wear clean clothes and solid shoes or boots. **NO TENNIS SHOES!**
11. Fair entries are due to the Junior Fair Coordinator's office, PO Box 80279, Canton, OH 44708, by **JULY 23, 2010**. Failure to enter, or late entry return, will eliminate you from competition. No stall space will be provided for your animals. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
12. The Junior Fair Beef Committee reserves the right to remove any animal from the show if that animal is unruly and a threat to the safety of other animals or people.
13. The Junior Fair Beef Committee will make the determination of any grievances and class disputes.
14. All beef feeder calves will be weighed in after market beef – Tuesday at the fair.
15. Animals may not be taken from the fairgrounds before the time specified by the Senior Fairboard. All displays **must** remain intact until 6:00 pm the last day of the fair. At that time all displays and decorations must be removed. **BARN WILL BE CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC AT 4:00 P.M. for LOAD OUT OF MARKET ANIMALS.**
16. The Board of Directors of the Stark County Agricultural Society will, to the best of their ability, safeguard persons, livestock and articles on the grounds, but will not be responsible for injury, damage, disease, theft, or loss of any kind.
17. All grooming chutes and awnings must be at least twelve feet from the dairy barn and the goat/sheep barn.
18. All grooming chutes must be removed from the fairgrounds by 10:00 a.m. Sunday after the shows. All awnings must be removed by 10:00 p.m. Thursday after the shows.
19. All fans must be placed at the sides or at the heads of the animals. **Absolutely no "butt" fans will be permitted.**

DEATH OF PROJECT ANIMALS

In the event that a project animal dies after the designated possession and/or weigh-in date, members **will not** be permitted to replace the animal for the purpose of exhibition or sale in any Junior Fair event (including carcass classes.) Members are expected to report immediately the death of any project animal to the respective animal committee member.

BEEF BREEDING CLASSES

- Class 1 Females born between January 1, 2010 - May 1, 2010.
Class 2 Females born between September 1, 2009 - December 31, 2009.
Class 3 Females born between May 1, 2009 – August 31, 2009.
Class 4 Females born between January 1, 2009 – April 30, 2009.
Class 5 Females born between January 1, 2008 – December 31, 2008. If animal has freshened, calf must be exhibited.
Class 6 Any animal that has freshened or heifer born before January 1, 2008, but not over 3 years of age at time of fair. If the animal has freshened, the calf must be exhibited.
Class 7 Junior Bull Calf – born after January 1, 2010.
Grand Champion Beef Breeding – includes all breed champions. Does not include feeder calves.

BEEF BREEDING AND FEEDER CALF SHOWMANSHIP – (age as of show day)

SENIOR SHOWMANSHIP – 16 years of age and over.

INTERMEDIATE SHOWMANSHIP – Ages 13 - 15

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP - Ages 9 – 12

BEEF FEEDER CALF RULES & RECOMMENDATIONS

1. All feeder calves must be born on or between January 1, 2010 and June 1, 2010.
2. Feeder calves will be shown by weight and split into two classes.
3. Beef feeders must be steers.
4. Feeder Calf steers must be castrated by August 1.
